



# IB Diploma

## Results 2020

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the examinations for the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB DP) have been modified. According to these modifications, Berlin Metropolitan School is proud to announce the examination outcomes for the Class of 2020. Over the course of 18 months, 51 students completed the full IB Diploma Programme and received the following results:

- An overall average of 34 points, exceeding the world average of 30 points.
- Six BMS students achieved over 40 points.
- 49% of BMS students were awarded the bilingual diploma, exceeding the world average of 25%.
- 97% of students obtained their first or second choice university placement.

\* DP Students pass the program by collecting a minimum of 24 points and a maximum of 45 points, as an accumulation of obtaining a numerical grade from 1-7 for each individual subject. The scale of assessment is set a 7 as the highest level of achievement and 1 as the lowest level of achievement.
