In addition to the course program, we offer workshops, games and activities throughout the year. With more than 980 course spots, the program offers a great diversity of activities that allow every student to find a fitting course or workshop. In addition to the diversity and number of courses we offer, we focus on providing quality educational programs. At the end of a school year, project work is displayed, performances are given, artwork is showcased, and tournaments are held. Every course teacher in our afternoon program is a qualified instructor.

Linking the CCEP with the curriculum of the Primary and Secondary Schools provides relevance and embeds the CCEP in the school program. Sports, art and creativity, exercises to train mental ability, languages, and technology are key elements of our academic program and are the central topics around which the after-school program is built.

In addition to these options, our students can also take advantage of musical instrument lessons at our school thanks to our collaboration with diverse music schools. Aside from the options provided by the clubs, the CCEP team organizes various workshops on different topics throughout the year in which students have the opportunity to discover new interests.
