

# Tuition Structure

## School Fees Early Learning

The parental contribution towards day care (KiTa-Gutschein/voucher) is scaled according to family income and hours of subsidized day care according to the Child Care Co-Payment Act (TKGB). In addition, there is a tuition fee, which is also scaled according to the hours subsidized as per TKGB:

Day care (as per notification)	
Half-day	EUR 300
All-day	EUR 250
Tuition without KiTa-Gutschein/voucher	EUR 650

## School Fees Grades 1-10

Parents may opt for an income-adjusted tuition rate for their child. The monthly school fee is then based on the child's grade level and on the family's income (sum of all positive gross earnings of the legal guardians). The various tuition fee levels are listed in the table below. To receive an income-adjusted tuition rate, parents must submit a copy of their most recent income tax report.

Should parents decide against applying for an income-adjusted tuition rate or fail to submit their tax report, the highest rates will apply, as outlined in the table below.

## Parental Contribution for Day Care (Hort) – grades 1-4

Parents must register their child for day care, from 1.30 to 6 pm, at their local district office. Proof of registration must be submitted to the school. The parental contribution is income-based and in accordance with the Child Care Co-Payment Act (TKGB).

If a child is only registered for day care ending at 4 pm, the fee increases by EUR 65 per month.

### Parental Contribution for Day Care (Hort) – grades 5-6

If proof of registration for day care is submitted for a child in grades 5 and 6, the tuition fees will be adjusted accordingly.

If a child is not registered with the local district office and no day care form is submitted, there is an additional charge of EUR 450 per month for the service.

### Admission Fees – apply from grade 1

Families must pay a one-time admission fee of EUR 850 per child. For families with a gross annual income of less than EUR 40,000 this one-time admission fee is the same amount as their monthly tuition fee.

### Fee Reduction

We offer a reduction in tuition fees for siblings. The first sibling receives a 15% reduction and the second and all further siblings receive a 25% reduction.

No tuition fees are charged for the second sibling from an annual income of EUR 110,000 and above.

## Media Fees

### Analog Media

The school provides students with textbooks and other educational materials and parents are charged a lump sum to cover the costs. The media fees are grade-level specific and listed in the following table.

### Digital Media

The fees for digital media are grade level-specific and listed in the following table.

## Lunch

The parental contribution towards lunch is EUR 60 per month.

## Other Fees

Fees for external test, exams, field trips and other activities are outlined and charged separately.

## Payment in Case of Early Withdrawal

If a student withdraws early from school, the terms agreed in the contract apply. These terms and conditions include giving the school proper notice of the intended withdrawal.

Non-refundable fees include the admission fee, as well as other one-time fees already paid. Tuition must be paid for an additional three months following an early withdrawal
