Results 2018

The Berlin Metropolitan School is proud to announce our International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IG-CSE) results from Cambridge Assessment International Education. Representing our largest cohort to date, 62 students completed 492 individual examinations with excellent grades. The 2018 IGCSE results represent our strongest academic outcomes thus far, with exceptional highlights such as the highest amount of A* to A Grades ever achieved as well as the highest amount of A* to C grades on record.

IGCSE examinations are comparable to the GCSE examinations taken in the United Kingdom. Here is a comparison between the results obtained at Berlin Metropolitan School and the results achieved by students in the United Kingdom¹.

Cambridge IGCSE subjects are assessed on an eight-point grade scale: A*, A, B, C, D, E, F, G. Grade A* is for the highest level of achievement. Grade G is for minimum satisfactory performance.
