

# IB Diploma

## Results 2016

Over the past 18 months, 44 BMS students prepared for their final DP Examinations. 41 students completed the entire IB Diploma and 3 students completed the subject certificate program.

As a whole, 37 students passed the IB DP Examinations, achieving an overall BMS pass rate of 90.2%, well over the world-wide pass rate of 80.8% in 2015.

On average, BMS achieved an overall point average of 31.1, in line with the world average of 30.1 points. Our students are slightly above the world-wide average, which is an excellent outcome for the first BMS cohort of students completing the program.

31 students obtained a bilingual diploma, which represents 83.8% of the total cohort. BMS was again able to achieve results above the world-wide average in this category, which is at 28.5% for students obtaining bilingual diplomas.

\* DP Students pass the program by collecting a minimum of 24 points and a maximum of 45 points, as an accumulation of obtaining a numerical grade from 1-7 for each individual subject. The scale of assessment is set a 7 as the highest level of achievement and 1 as the lowest level of achievement.
