

IGCSE Results 2015

The Berlin Metropolitan School is pleased to announce the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) results from Cambridge University. 44 students completed over 310 individual examinations with excellent grades.

Cambridge IGCSE subjects are assessed on an eight-point grade scale: A*, A, B, C, D, E, F, G. Grade A* is for the highest level of achievement. Grade G is for minimum satisfactory performance.
