

IGCSE Results 2016

The Berlin Metropolitan School is pleased to announce the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) results from Cambridge International Examinations. 46 students completed over 330 individual examinations with excellent grades.

Cambridge IGCSE subjects are assessed on an eight-point grade scale: A*, A, B, C, D, E, F, G. Grade A* is for the highest level of achievement. Grade G is for minimum satisfactory performance.
