The Mittlerer Schulabschluss (MSA) is a national school leaving certificate for students completing the 10th grade. 45 students from Berlin Metropolitan School completed the examinations for this certificate and achieved excellent results. Below is a detailed evaluation of the results in comparison to the Berlin average.

MSA subjects are assessed on an six-point grade scale: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6. Grade 1 is for the highest level of achievement. Grade 5 is for minimum satisfactory performance.
