

Tuition Structure

School Grades 1-12

Parents may opt for an income-adjusted tuition rate for their child. The monthly school fee is then based on the child's grade level and on the family's income (sum of all positive earnings). The various tuition levels are outlined in the table below. To receive an income-adjusted tuition rate, parents must submit a copy of their most recent income tax report.

Should parents decide against applying for an income-adjusted tuition rate or fail to submit their tax report, the highest rates will apply, as outlined in the table below.

Parental Contribution for Day Care (Hort) – grades 1-6

For the possibility of day care, from 1.30 pm to 6 pm, a day care voucher registration at the local district office is advised. The parental contribution is then income-based and in accordance with the Child Care Co-Payment Act (TKBG).

In the case that there is a day care voucher available only up to 4 pm, instead of up to 6 pm, the fee increases by EUR 65 per month. If there is the request for day care but no day care voucher is submitted, monthly fees of EUR 450 will be borne by the parents.

Admission Fees

Families must pay a one-time admission fee of EUR 1,100 per child. For families with a gross annual income of less than EUR 40.000 this one-time fee is the same amount as their monthly tuition fee.

Fee Reduction

We offer a reduction in tuition fees for siblings.

Second child	15% discount
Third child	25% discount
Fourth and all further children	100% discount

Media Fees

Analog Media

The school provides students with textbooks and other educational materials and parents are charged a lump sum to cover the costs. The media fees are grade-level specific and listed in the following table.

The analog media fee is to be paid annually, independent of the entry date of the child.

Digital Media

The fees for digital media are grade level-specific and listed in the following table.

The digital media fee is to be paid annually, independent of the entry date of the child.

Lunch

The parental contribution towards lunch is EUR 70 per month.

Miscellaneous Fees

There are examination fees to be taken into account for the IGCSE and IB Diploma exams. These examination fees are to be separately calculated. This also applies to additional external tests, trips and class excursions as well as other additional activities.

No additional fees will be charged for the MSA (Mittlerer Schulabschluss) examinations nor for the BBR (Berufsbildungsreife) vocational training.

Fee system for compliance with the special prohibition pursuant to Article 7 of the constitutional law

For families with an annual combined income below 30,000 EUR (sum of all positive gross earnings of the legal guardians), the school fees for the oldest child will be 100 EUR per month, for the second child, 75 EUR, for the third child 50 EUR and for all further children 25 EUR.

There will be no admission fees applicable.

The teaching materials cost is calculated as 100 EUR per child per school year. With the submission of relevant documents pertaining to unemployment benefits (Arbeitslosengeld II), social support (Sozialhilfe), social benefits (Sozialgeld) or benefits from the Benefits for Asylum Seekers Act, the teaching materials fee will be waived. We will furthermore support the families with regards to costs involved for class excursions.
